

# CODINGTON CONSERVATION DISTRICT SERVICES FOR 2018

## Tree Planting

### Machine Plantings:

- 3' to 5' spacing = \$7.25/rod (shrubs)
- 6' to 10' spacing = \$6.40/rod (deciduous)
- 8' to 10' spacing = \$6.70/rod (conifers)
- **\$415 minimum charge**

### Hand Plants:

- \$1.85 each/bundle of 25 (same species)
- \$2.75 each Bare root single
- Potted and taller trees = \$2.75 and up
- Tree Packs  
(5 species/25 trees=\$46.25)  
(10 trees = \$33.00)

### Hand Plant Auger Rental (2 Available):

- \$50/full day
- \$25/half day

**Replants:** \$1.10 per tree for prior year only  
(This is only if district's crew planted your trees the prior year. \*The District does not plant these.)

**35% DOWNPAYMENT** of total estimated tree planting cost is due prior to ordering trees for you planting. This down payment is non-refundable.

**Up to maximum of \$200 stop charge if tree site isn't prepared when crew arrives, after producer has been notified and said it would be ready**

### TREE PRODUCTS

- Transfilm - \$10.00/pint
- Plantskydd - \$10 - \$23.00 (Deer & rabbit repellent)
- 5' Tree Tubes w/ Stake = \$7.00

Price of all items includes **6.5% sales tax**.

## Tree Fabric

We do offer fabric as option for weed maintenance.

- Installation =\$10.00/rod
- Rolls of fabric and boxes of staples may be purchased as well.
- Fabric =\$175.00/Roll
  - Staples =\$85.00/Box (500 Count)
  - Individual Staples =\$0.20/Staple

## Cultivation Service

The Codington Conservation District has six weed badgers, three diggers and one disc available for cultivating tree sites. Sign up by **APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup>** to be on the route for the season.

- Signed contracts will need to be renewed yearly in order to be on the route.
- Contract includes minimum of 3 visits, maximum of 4 visits to your tree site on a rotational basis during the season. Approximately every 4-6 weeks.
- \$300/acre season contract for cleaning in tree row(s) and between tree rows
- \$325/acre/season for late sign-up
- 35% down payment required before cultivation starts
- **\$350 minimum charge**
- Contract includes minimum of 3 visits, maximum of 4 visits to your tree site on a rotational basis during the season. Approximately every 4-6 weeks.
- On call charge \$90/hour after contracted 4<sup>th</sup> visit

## Private Lands

### Woody Habitat Program

SD Game, Fish & Parks will reimburse producers 75% of costs incurred for planting woody habitat for wildlife.

- Maximum payment of \$10,000 per planting per year
- New planting must be minimum of 8 rows wide and 1 acre in size
- Plantings cannot be made in native sod or land converted from native sod to cropland after 2008
- Only certain species of trees may be planted in these sites based on the number of rows and acres in the shelterbelt.

## CRP Cost Share

Cost share may be available through the Continuous CRP Program. Contact the FSA Office to check eligibility and to sign up for cost share

## DISTRICT GRANT COST SHARE

Grant funds may be available through the Conservation District for a limited number of eligible tree plantings.

## TREE SITE GRASS SEEDING

The Codington Conservation District offers grass seeding in older, larger tree sites as a method of weed control. Price includes grass seed and planting. Out of county seeding will be charged \$2.00/mile one way from county line.

- \$160.00 per acre
- **\$160.00 minimum charge**

## NO-TILL DRILL RENTAL

The Codington Conservation District has a 1590 John Deere 20' No-Till Drill equipped with a fertilizer attachment and seed agitator available for rent. (100 HP tractor needed)

- \$13.00 acre *plus \$25/day if drill isn't used in a timely manner*
- \$150.00 minimum charge (11 ac. or less)
- \$100 charge if drill is not cleaned out by renter after use.

## GRASS DRILL & OPERATOR

The Codington Conservation District has a 15 foot no-till Great Plains grass drill which is ideal for seeding the fluffy seed mixtures called for on CRP acres. Drill, tractor and operator can be hired for:

- \$21/acre
- **\$200 minimum (10 ac. or less)**

**Note:** Owner must purchase own see for use in the drills.

Seed is available to purchase through the Conservation District, contact the office for a quote.
